Our 'Improve Your Sight Reading' workshop in October 2018 was so popular that we are now re-running a similar workshop.

But do not be deterred if you missed the 2018 Workshop. This follow up, structured day will start with a recap of the basics of musical notation, rhythm and notes, and then follow on to look at scales, sharps and flats, key signatures, and the difference between major and minor. There will also be plenty of opportunities to ask questions At the end there will be an opportunity to put the lessons into practice by singing a simple piece of music, in multiple parts, from the score.

Whilst materials will be provided, it would be advisable to bring a pencil and paper to make any additional notes.

After the workshop, music at your choir rehearsals will make more sense and rehearsals will be more productive and enjoyable.

The cost is just £15. Tea, coffee, and EPMS legendary cakes will be available for a small charge. Please bring your own lunch.
